

VISIONING SESSIONS (STEP TWO) IN SEPTEMBER

VISIONING: STEP TWO. Sessions - SAT, SEP 9: 9:00am-11:45am (Option 1); 1:00pm-3:45pm (Option 2) - Since our August 12 initial meeting considered the recent and current identity and ministry of FPC-Bryan, meeting #2 will consider where God is calling this congregation to be. We will articulate some possibilities for the next steps for the life and ministry of this congregation. PREPARATION: Be looking at some of your favorite hymns and read the words to these hymns.

In a follow-up email to Session from Visioning Facilitators David and Judy Fletcher, they wrote: "You, the Session, are to be commended for taking the time to share and listen to thoughts about the FPC membership from their Saturday gatherings. The people who participated in the process on Saturday were energetic, very positive about the church for the most part, and very willing to offer helpful and insightful comments.

A total of 61 people participated in both sessions, 40 in the morning and 21 in the afternoon which represents well over 10% of the congregation and over 25% of the most regularly attending members. The group offered comments about hope for the future of this church, pride in the facility, gratitude for the paying off of the HVAC loan indebtedness, and upward membership trends. All positives. Bottom line, this is a healthy congregation with a vibrant future. Are there issues? Definitely, but this process is uncovering them, and we observe a Session that stands ready to address them."

What remains of the immediate/current Visioning Process is for members of the congregation to participate (as many as are available) in one of the sessions on Sept 9, and for all to continue to pray for God's blessing as we discuss and discern God's best intentions for us in ministry together during the days and years ahead.

Participation on September 9 is open to all members, even those who were not able to participate on August 12. (See article inside on how to still participate in Visioning: Step One.)

HVAC GIVING UPDATE

Dear First Presbyterian Members and Friends,

It is time for an update on our HVAC giving. Our Three Year Pledge Campaign has five months remaining. The congregation's dedication to reducing our loan principal has been exceptional. The approximately \$1.4 million loan has been amazingly reduced to a current loan balance of \$291,000.

I would like to discuss in more detail the 2017 giving to HVAC. Out of the fifty-six pledges for the final year of 2017, six have fulfilled their pledge and fifty have part or all of their pledge still out. Through July we have received almost \$43,000 with another \$59,000 still due. Assuming we receive the total amount still due from our pledges and adding the \$40,000 from the FPC Foundation, our remaining loan amount after the end of the 2017 year would be reduced to approximately \$192,000.

Please consider the state of your 2017 HVAC giving and let's end this final year of our three year campaign with a bang!
